We have recently taken part in Operation Portcullis and Operation Sabre which have been focusing on alcohol related disorder and targeting wanted offenders respectively.

Both operations have proved successful as we continue to make your neighbourhood as safe as possible.

However, we can only do so much and you need to take a few simple steps to keep your property safe.

To ensure you don't give burglars an opportunity to get into your home, please keep doors and windows locked even when you are in. One in three burglaries are down to thieves getting in from insecure doors and windows. Keep valuables and gadgets out of sight and away from windows. Use lights, radios and timer switches, this will make your home look occupied.

By reporting crime, you are giving out the message to those who want to steal or cause trouble that their actions will not be tolerated. To report a crime, call 0161 872 5050 or Crimestoppers, anonymously, 0800 555 111.

To avoid falling victim to vehicle crime, take all valuables out of your vehicle, remove the CD or stereo fascia, take all items out of your glove compartment and leave it open so thieves can see it is empty. Wipe away any marks left by your sat nav.
