SERIOUS WOUNDING OFFENCES

Wounding with intent to do Grievous Bodily Harm (GBH) (Sec 18)
Shooting at Naval or Revenue Vessels
Attempting to choke/suffocate etc
Wounding: using chloroform etc
Burning maiming etc by explosion
Causing explosion or casting corrosive fluids with intent
Impeding the saving of life from a shipwreck

LESS SERIOUS WOUNDING OFFENCES

Malicious wounding – wound or inflict GBH (s20)
Administer poison with intent to injure or annoy
Setting spring guns etc to injure trespassers
Cause bodily harm by furious driving
Assault on person preserving wreck
Assault occasioning actual bodily harm (s47)
Possess offensive weapon without lawful authority
Possess firearm/imitation – commit/arrested for sch1 offence
Possess shotgun/imitation – commit/arrested for sch1 offence
Possess airweapon/imitation – commit/arrested for sch1 offence
Possess firearm/imitation with intent – commit indictable offence/resist arrest
Possess shotgun/imitation with intent – commit indictable offence/resist arrest
Possess airweapon/imitation with intent – commit indictable offence/resist arrest
Assault with intent to resist arrest/assault a person assisting a constable
Allowing dog to be dangerously out of control in a public place
Allowing dog to enter a non-public place and injure a person
