I write in connection with your request for information dated 09th May 2008. I note you seek access to the following information:

1. Please can you provide me with a breakdown on the number of Fixed Penalty Notices (FPNs) and Penalty Notice Disorders (PNDs) that your force has handed out since they were introduced in 2001?
2. Can you breakdown the FPNs and PNDs into the offences they were for? Have there been any handed out for offences as serious as, or more serious than, Actual Bodily Harm and Greivous Bodily Harm?
3. Can you also please tell me what percentage of these FPNs and PNDs have been paid up and how many remain unpaid?

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by Greater Manchester Police.
