The same regulation also abolishes 'housing emoluments' in the principal regulations 49 to 52B but preserves serving officers rights to them.

'Housing emoluments' are:

- housing allowance
- transitional rent allowance
- transitional supplementary rent allowance
- supplementary housing allowance.
- compensatory grant, and
- compensatory allowance.

These 'housing emoluments' will be known as a 'replacement allowance' and they will be frozen at the rate they were being paid immediately before the 1st September 1994.

Housing allowance

With effect from the 1st September 1994 officers joining the service will no longer have a right to accommodation free of rent or a housing allowance. The Chief Constable may, however provide an officer with accommodation if it is necessary for operational reasons.

Officers in provided accommodation who leave that accommodation after the 1st September 1994 will be entitled to a 'replacement allowance'.
