I write in connection with your request for information dated 26/07/2023, I note you seek access to the following information:

Please can you provide a breakdown on the following information:

- (a) the number of recorded burglary offences in the Hale Barns area for the most recent reporting period.*
- (b) the number of recorded burglary offences in the Timperley area for the most recent reporting period.*
- (c) the total number of people charged with burglary offences Hale Barns area for the most recent reporting period.*
- (d) the total number of people charged with burglary offences Timperley area for the most recent reporting period.*
- (e) the total number of offences for burglary where the investigation was completed and no offender was identified in the Hale Barns area for the most recent reporting period.*
- (f) the total number of offences for burglary where the investigation was completed and no offender was identified in the Timperley area for the most recent reporting period.*

Note: When referencing the Hale Barns area and Timperley area we mean the local neighbourhood police area that includes these local areas.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by Greater Manchester Police.

Caveats

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.

- This data contains crimes with a created date between 01/04/2022 and 31/03/2023, HO Codes 028/03, 029/00, 030/02, and 031/00, with beats Hale Barns, Timperley Central, Timperley South, and Timperley East excluding cancelled crimes. Further information about cancelled crimes can be obtained from the Home Office Counting Rules.
- Please note, the (c) to (f) data is the count of the crime outcome rather than suspect's outcome, and there may be more than one suspect attached to each crime.
 - '(c) the total number of people charged with burglary offences Hale Barns area for the most recent reporting period.' – crime outcome '1A Charged' applied.
 - '(d) the total number of people charged with burglary offences Timperley area for the most recent reporting period.' – crime outcome '1A Charged' applied.
 - '(e) the total number of offences for burglary where the investigation was completed and no offender was identified in the Hale Barns area for the most recent reporting period.' – crime outcome '18 Investigation Complete - No Suspect Identified' applied.
 - '(f) the total number of offences for burglary where the investigation was completed and no offender was identified in the Timperley area for the most recent reporting period.' – crime outcome '18 Investigation Complete - No Suspect Identified' applied.
- The data for a specific location may include crimes that did not happen in that location and/or exclude crimes that did.
 - Some crimes do not have a beat code, which means that they cannot be mapped to other geographies e.g. districts.
 - Some crimes have an incorrect beat code, which means that they are mapped to the wrong geographies.
