- *Ascot Avenue, Sale M33 4QT*
- *Ascot Avenue, Sale M33 4GT*
- *Kempton Avenue, Sale M33 4GU*
- *Kempton Avenue, Sale M33 4GZ*

Please include incidents regardless of charge or prosecution and any anti-social behaviour.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by Greater Manchester Police.

Caveats

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.

Incident data:

- This data contains incidents with a created date between 1st August 2022 and 31st July 2023, excluding incidents with a closing code of L10 Duplicate, L19 Error or L22 Test

or training where the incident location postcode is recorded as M33 4XW, M334XW, M33 4BY, M334BY, M33 4QZ, M334QZ, M33 4QT, M334QT, M33 4GT, M334GT, M33 4GU, M334GU, M33 4GZ or M334GZ.

- The data for a specific location may include incidents that did not happen in that location and/or exclude incidents that did
 - Some incidents do not have an address because e.g. the address has been recorded in a non-standard format or as map coordinates.
- There can be more than one closing code attached to an incident. For this reason, the number of count on the Closure Code is not the same as the number of incidents.

Crime data:

- This data contains crimes with a created date between 1st August 2022 and 31st July 2023, with the crime location postcode M33 4XW, M334XW, M33 4BY, M334BY, M33 4QZ, M334QZ, M33 4QT, M334QT, M33 4GT, M334GT, M33 4GU, M334GU, M33 4GZ or M334GZ, excluding cancelled crimes. Further information about cancelled crimes can be obtained from the Home Office Counting Rules.
- The data for a specific location may include crimes that did not happen in that location and/or exclude crimes that did.
 - Some crimes do not have an address because e.g. the address has been recorded in a non-standard format or as map coordinates.
- These crimes may have originated from incidents in the incident data and refer to the same circumstances.

Due to the low results, the information marked “X” have been exempted from disclosure under **Section 40(2) Personal Information** – this information constitutes personal data of an identifiable living individual, and to disclose this information would breach the principles of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018. Personal data is defined by Section 1 of the Data Protection Act 1998 and means data that relates to an individual who can be identified directly or indirectly from that data.

In accordance with the Section 17 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, this letter acts as a Refusal Notice for those particular pieces of information.
