I write in connection with your request for information dated 29/09/2023, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

I'm working on the impact of stress and mental ill-health on Police Scotland officers.

I've got some FOI data on the number of days lost to mental ill-health by the force in Scotland - specifically annual figures on absences of officers and staff for reasons related to mental ill-health - and wanted to ask for similar data from GMP - ideally annual figures for these absences over the past decade.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate the requested information and I can confirm the information requested is held by GMP.

Caveats

The information is reported by financial year, 1st April to 31st March.

Data provided is from Sickness Cubes as of 31st March per relevant year, with the exception of 2023 which is year to date as of 30th September 2023.

Based on Estimated Working Days Lost New and Dorset 12 category Psychological Disorder.

The figure for Police Staff includes Police community Support Officers.
