I write in connection with your request for information dated 07/09/2023, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

since 2022 up to August 31st 2023 how many cyclists in Greater Manchester have been prosecuted for the following offences:-

- 1. Dangerous cycling on a road***
- 2. careless and inconsiderate cycling***
- 3. Cycle on a road or public place under the influence of drink or drugs***
- 4. Cycling carrying more than 1 person on the bike (unless the bike has been adapted)***
- 5. Cyclist holding on to a vehicle Riding an electrically assisted***
- 6. cycle under age Fined for cycling on the pavement Not obey road signals e.g Red light jumping.***
- 7. Also Since 2022 how many motorists have been Charged / prosecuted under the rule "Causing serious injuries due to careless and inconsiderate driving" and how many of these involved cyclists***
