I write in connection with your request for information dated 20/07/2023, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

I would like to make an official FOI request from GMP's road policing team for the following.

Q1 How many times per day/week does this team patrol and police the Mancunian way?

Q2 Since the new legal 30MPH limit was lowered from 50mph, how many vehicles have GMP's road policing team stopped for speeding above the legal 30MPH limit on the Mancunian Way?

Q3 Since the new 30MPH legal limit was imposed, how many vehicles have GMP's road policing unit issued fixed penalty notices to drivers caught speeding over 30MPH on the Mancunian Way?

Q4 How many GMP road policing unit officers patrol this road every day?

Q5 When will the public see visible enforcement of the 30MPH legal speed limit on this road by GMP's road policing unit?

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate the requested information and I can confirm the information requested is held by GMP.

Question 1 – No information held. Mancunian Way is patrolled by traffic officers throughout their course of duties however when incidents come in the traffic officers are assigned to deal with the traffic matters.

Question 2 – No information held. GMP do not record the number of vehicles “stopped”.

Question 3 – There has been 10 fixed penalty notices submitted by GMP officers for exceeding 30mph speed limit since February 2022.

Question 4 – No information held. Mancunian Way is patrolled by traffic officers throughout their course of duties however when incidents come in the traffic officers are assigned to deal with the traffic matters.

Question 5 – There will not be a visible enforcement on this road because any vehicle being dealt with is taken off the road due to the location.
