I write in connection with your request for information dated 08/08/2023, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

For insurance purposes, I would like to understand what is the expected reaction time for armed response in case of intruder alarm triggers.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate the requested information and I can confirm the information requested is held by GMP.

However, I am not obliged to supply all the information you have requested as exemptions apply.

When refusing to provide such information because an exemption applies, Section 17(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 requires GMP, to provide you - the applicant - with a notice which: (a) states that fact, (b) specifies the exemption in question and (c) states (if that would not otherwise be apparent) why the exemption applies.

The requested information is exempt under section 21 – Information accessible to applicant by other means. The information referred to is already available in the Public Domain. Please follow the links below.
