FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE NO: 01/FOI/23/011308/Z

I write in connection with your request for information dated 11/09/2023, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

Please provide all data of complaints received in relation to the Muslim Heritage Centre in M16 8BP since the License was granted for the Marquee for events.

These should include the nature of the complaint, the date the complaint was made and the action taken on the part of Greater Manchester Police to investigate and resolve the issues.

Clarification received - Please could we look at the last three years - 2021 -2022 and 2023.

Further clarification below

Question 1 - how many 'incidents' have you had reported, what were they - ie: noise, alleged breach of license, anti-social behaviour etc ... - and when were these reported?

Question 2 - how many of these 'incidents' were triaged to become 'crimed'?

Question 3 - what actions were taken as a result of these incidents being crimed?

Question 4 - what were the outcomes of these actions?

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate the requested information and I can confirm the information requested is held by GMP.

However, I am not obliged to provide all the information as an exemption applies. See below.

Section 17 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 requires Greater Manchester Police, when refusing to provide such information (because this information is exempt) to provide you, the applicant, with a

notice which: (a) states that fact, (b) specifies the exemption in question and (c) states (if that would not otherwise be apparent) why the exemption applies.

Section 40 is an absolute exemption with no requirement to complete a public interest test.

The date of the incidents for **question 1** has been exempted from disclosure under **Section 40(2) Personal Information** – this information constitutes personal data of an identifiable living individual, and to disclose this information would breach the principles of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018. Personal data is defined by Section 1 of the Data Protection Act 1998 and means data that relates to an individual who can be identified directly or indirectly from that data.

Caveats:

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.

- This data contains incidents with the postcode 'M16 8BP' and contains 'Muslim Heritage Centre' somewhere within the address, with a created date between 1st January 2021 and 25th September 2023, excluding incidents with a closing code of L10 Duplicate, L19 Error or L22 Test or training.
- The address recorded may not be where the crime happened e.g. where the crime happened in the street and the address was used as a reference point.
- Some incidents do not have an address because e.g. the address has been recorded in a non-standard format or as map coordinates.
- The system does not account for spelling errors

Question 1 - Please see the incident totals per category for each year from 1st January 2021 and 25th September 2023.
