I write in connection with your request for information dated 01/03/2024, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

I am writing to make an open government request for all the information to which I am entitled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. Please would provide details of your current contract covering reprographics/print arrangements as follows

1. *Number of Multi-functional devices at Greater Manchester Police*
2. *Name of current supplier?*
3. *Contract start and duration (if now ended, when do you plan to revisit the marketplace)?*
4. *Is there an option to extend this contract?*
5. *Does GMP have a print room? If yes, when does the contract end?*
6. *Do you have additional printers? if yes how many and is there a contract?*
7. *What route to market – open tender or framework, if yes which one used?*
8. *Who is responsible for this contract?*

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by GMP. However, I am not obliged to supply you with all of the information as an exemption applies.

Section 17 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 requires Greater Manchester Police, when refusing to provide such information (because this information is exempt) to provide you, the applicant, with a notice which: (a) states that fact, (b) specifies the exemption in question and (c) states (if that would not otherwise be apparent) why the exemption applies. The information you have requested in question 8 is exempt from disclosure by virtue of the following exemption: **Section 40(2) – Personal Information.**

Where Section 40 has been used, this represents information that identifies a living individual, to disclose this information would breach the principles of the GDPR and the Data Protection Act 2018. Personal data is defined by Article 4 of the GDPR and Part 1 of the Data Protection Act 2018 and means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person ('data subject'). An identified natural person is one who can be identified directly or indirectly from that data.

In accordance with the Section 17 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, this letter acts as a Refusal Notice for that piece of information.
