I write in connection with your request for information dated 02/11/2024, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

I would like to formally request a freedom of information request for :

1. The number of crimes submitted between 2006 and 2009 by [REDACTED]
2. The number of crimes submitted between 2009 and 2018 by [REDACTED]
3. Number of arrests made by [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] between 2007 and 2018
4. Number of people interviewed as witness/suspect in Op Ector between 2018 and 2023

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by GMP. However, I am not obliged to supply you with all the information as an exemption applies.

Section 17 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 requires Greater Manchester Police, when refusing to provide such information (because this information is exempt) to provide you, the applicant, with a notice which: (a) states that fact, (b) specifies the exemption in question and (c) states (if that would not otherwise be apparent) why the exemption applies. The information you have requested in questions 1, 2 and 3 is exempt from disclosure by virtue of the following exemption: **Section 40(1) – Personal Information**. Where S40 has been used, this represents information that constitutes personal data of which you, the applicant, is the data subject.

Question 4 is not exempt and I can confirm that this information is held by GMP. In total, 20 individuals were interviewed as part of Operation Ector. 14 were interviewed as witnesses and 6 were interviewed as suspects.
