FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE NO: FOI/24/013746/U

I write in connection with your request for information dated 28/11/2024, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

I would like to know how many Traffic Offence Reports were issued on Moss Vale Crescent, Stretford, M32 between 1st September 2024 and 28th November 2024.

I would also like to know what collar numbers issued the TOR's.

I would then like to know how many other TOR's the relevant officers issued during that time and on what roads in Trafford.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate the requested information and I can confirm the information requested is held by GMP. However, I am not obliged to provide all the information requested as exemption applies.

Section 17 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 requires Greater Manchester Police, when refusing to provide such information (because this information is exempt) to provide you, the applicant, with a notice which: (a) states that fact, (b) specifies the exemption in question and (c) states (if that would not otherwise be apparent) why the exemption applies.

Section 40 is an absolute exemption with no requirement to complete a public interest test.

The collar numbers of the officers and the totals per officer have been exempted from disclosure under Section 40(2) Personal Information – this information constitutes personal data of an identifiable living individual, and to disclose this information would breach the principles of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018. Personal data is defined by Section 1 of the Data

Protection Act 2018 and means data that relates to an individual who can be identified directly or indirectly from that data.

Response

Q - I would like to know how many Traffic Offence Reports were issued on Moss Vale Crescent, Stretford, M32 between 1st September 2024 and 28th November 2024.

I would also like to know what collar numbers issued the TOR's.

The total number of TOR's processed by CTO is 14 for this location and date range.

Q - I would then like to know how many other TOR's the relevant officers issued during that time and on what roads in Trafford.

Due to low numbers returned the location of the TOR and the officer details have been exempt from disclosure under Section 40(2) Personal Information – this information constitutes personal data of an identifiable living individual, and to disclose this information would breach the principles of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018. Personal data is defined by Section 1 of the Data Protection Act 2018 and means data that relates to an individual who can be identified directly or indirectly from that data.

The total number of TOR's processed by CTO to date is 9.
