I write in connection with your request for information dated 19/01/2024, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

According to the Daily Mail (based on a Sky News report), Dannika Stewart was told by a sergeant to drop all her complaints against the police:

Mother says she was forced to strip naked in a cell by Greater Manchester Police and told to drop complaints about the force | Daily Mail Online

A review is currently being carried out by Dame Vera Baird into the matter, and GMP has stated it wouldn't be appropriate to comment further until the review has concluded.

The article, however, refers to another concluded review carried out by Greater Manchester Combined Authority :

'Kate Green, deputy mayor for safer and stronger communities, undertook the review and revealed that the investigating officer 'did not review the CCTV footage from Ms Stewart's time in custody or provide her with an explanation as to why he did not review the CCTV footage or the audio recordings'.'

Please provide all information you have made public in response to the review carried out by Kate Green.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is not held by GMP. GMP have made no public comments on the review carried out by Kate Green.
