I write in connection with your request for information dated 10/12/2013, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

1) The number of road traffic accidents reported on Pemberton Road, Winstanley, Wigan in the last 5 years.

Please include the number of road traffic accidents at the following junctions with Pemberton Road:

*Winstanley Road
Holmes House Avenue
Billinge Road*

2) For all requested roads could you please itemise/specify the number of injuries and fatalities reported for all road users in each reported RTA.

3) Please could you provide the cause of each road traffic accident listed.

4) Please could you highlight each road traffic accident where excessive speed i.e over the speed limit was a factor or was reported, including the recorded or estimated speeds.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate the requested information and I can confirm the information requested is held by GMP.

1. 8 collisions recorded on Pemberton Road
 - a. 3 collisions at the junction with Winstanley Road
 - b. 0 collisions at the junction of Holmes House Avenue
 - c. 0 collisions at the junction with Billinge Road
2. All the above involved injuries to some extent. For the whole of Pemberton Road, 2 collisions resulted in "serious" injuries. The remaining 5 resulted in "slight" injuries. The three collisions at the junction with Winstanley Road resulted in "slight" injuries.

 - a. Collision 1 (Junction with Winstanley Road)
 - i. No contributory factors recorded
 - b. Collision 2 (Junction with Winstanley Road)
 - i. Disobeyed Give Way/Stop Sign
 - ii. Driver/rider failed to judge other person's path or speed
 - iii. Driver using mobile phone
 - c. Collision 3 (Junction with Winstanley Road)
 - i. Disobeyed Give Way/Stop Sign
 - ii. Driver/Rider careless/reckless/in a hurry
 - iii. Distraction in vehicle
 - d. Collision 4
 - i. Driver/Rider impaired by drugs (illegal or medicinal)
 - ii. Poor turn or manoeuvre
 - iii. Driver/Rider failed to look properly
 - iv. Driver/rider failed to judge other person's path or speed
 - v. Junction restart
 - vi. Other
 - e. Collision 5
 - i. Loss of control
 - ii. Road layout (e.g. bend, hill, narrow carriageway)
 - iii. Exceeding speed limit
 - iv. Slippery road (due to weather)
 - v. Learner or inexperienced driver/rider
 - f. Collision 6
 - i. No contributory factors recorded
 - g. Collision 7
 - i. No contributory factors recorded
 - h. Collision 8
 - i. No contributory factors recorded
4. One collision had a contributory factor of Exceeding the Speed Limit. The actual or estimated speed involved is not recorded.
