Can I please ask you to provide the crime types and numbers of recorded crimes between April 1st 2021 and April 30th 2024 in the Castleton neighbourhood policing area.

I can confirm that the data I require is for all the beats, i.e. the whole Castleton community.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by Greater Manchester Police.
