1. *How many student police officers joined Salford district between 2020 to 2022?*
2. *What was the ethnic background of the student officers that joined the Salford district between 2020 to 2022*
3. *How many of the student police officers who joined in 2020 to 2022, resigned, transferred districts, had their employment terminated? Please specify their ethnic background.*
4. *How many student officers on the Salford district have transferred to other districts between 2014 to 2024?*
5. *How many officers on the Salford district have been on sickness leave between 2020 to 2023?*
6. *How many of the officers on sickness leave on the Salford district between 2020 to 2023 have been provided reasonable adjustments?*
7. *How many officers on the Salford district have been on mental health related leave between 2020 to 2022?*
8. *How many student officers within Greater Manchester Police changed their districts between 2019 to 2024?*

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that some of the information you have requested is held by Greater Manchester Police.

Caveats

- The data provided recorded between 1st Jan 2020 - 31st December 2022

- Part 5 – Officer sickness case any length (1 day plus), based on the Officers location recorded as Salford at time of sickness case
- Part 6 – At some point after their sickness case they have been centrally recorded as being on adjusted or recuperative duty. We can only provide where the adjustment has been formally recorded after a period of sickness in the central HR system cannot correlate if this review was a result of the sickness case
- Part 7 – Recorded a psychological sickness absence during the above period, any sickness length (1 day plus)
