Result of Searches

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.

- Data has been provided for the period 01/01/2023 to 31/12/2023.
- Crimes searched using HO Codes requested.
- The year used is from the crime reference numbers for 2023.
- Where possible duplicates have been removed.

The data for 01/01/2024, the results between 1 to 5 have been marked 'X' and outcome breakdown for each offence – these information has been exempted from disclosure under **Section 40(2) Personal Information**.

The information constitutes personal data of an identifiable living individual, and to disclose this information would breach the principles of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018. Personal data is defined by Section 1 of the Data Protection Act 1998 and means data that relates to an individual who can be identified directly or indirectly from that data.
