I write in connection with your request for information dated 08/02/2024, I note you seek access to the following information:

I was wondering if I could receive stats regarding the number of women killed by men from 2021 - 2023.

Can I know the the age, race, ethnicity, etc. of these women and men?

Also, can the stats be based around murder offences only where the accused is or are male only, please?

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by Greater Manchester Police.

Caveats

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.

- The HO Codes used are 001/01 & 001/02 for Murder & Manslaughter for the period 01/01/2021 - 31/12/2023.
- The month relates to when the crime was recorded and not when the incident occurred.
- Where possible duplicates have been removed.
- The data has been filtered to female victims only.
- The data has then been filtered to male offenders only.
