I write in connection with your request for information dated 07/05/2024, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

I am not on a fishing trip or being vexatious I need this information as evidence from GMP to help secure convictions against two GMP employees involved in serious corruption like concealing paedophile crimes, international fraud and Public Office Holders passing intelligence to OCG's involved in the cocaine trade who commit murder that everyone knows about.

Please provide me with the recorded information relating to the Police Force that has jurisdiction for offences committed in the geographical [REDACTED] Postcode area.

Please provide me with all recorded information to evidence which Police Force or Service is responsible for collection of evidence within the [REDACTED] Postcode geographical area.

If GMP is responsible for the collection of evidence and investigations of suspects evidenced to have committed crimes against the integrity of the justice system please provide the recorded information on which Police Station is closest to or based in the geographical area commonly called [REDACTED] by the Post Office and most normal people in England (Or anywhere else in the world wanting to locate a building in England) use to find places with maps of any format.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by Greater Manchester Police. However, I am not obliged to supply all the information you have requested as exemptions apply.

When refusing to provide such information because an exemption applies, Section 17(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 requires GMP, to provide you - the applicant - with a notice which: (a) states that fact, (b) specifies the exemption in question and (c) states (if that would not otherwise be apparent) why the exemption applies.
