I write in connection with your request for information dated 18/11/2024, I note you seek access to the following information:

1. Please could you state the number of burglaries that you have recorded as having taken place on 25.12.23?

2. In relation to all of those offences recorded by you in Q.1 could you provide me with a table showing the Home Office prescribed Outcomes for all of those offences? Eg. Charged, Cautioned, Ongoing, Transferred to Other Force, Evidential Problems etc.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by Greater Manchester Police.

Caveats

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.

- This data contains crimes with a created date on 25th December 2023 where the Crime Tree Level 3 includes burglary, excluding cancelled crimes. Further information about cancelled crimes can be obtained from the Home Office Counting Rules.
