I write in connection with your request for information dated 13/08/2024, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

1. *What make, model and manufacturer of body worn cameras does your force use?*
2. *When did your current body worn camera contract start?*
3. *Which procurement route was used (e.g. was a framework used?)*
4. *How many devices do you have?*
5. *Roughly how much has been spent since contract start?*
6. *How much was spent in calendar year 2023?*
7. *When does your current contract expire?*
8. *Do your body worn cameras have live streaming capabilities?*

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by Greater Manchester Police. However, I am not obliged to supply all the information you have requested as an exemption applies.

When refusing to provide such information because an exemption applies, Section 17(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 requires GMP, to provide you - the applicant - with a notice which: (a) states that fact, (b) specifies the exemption in question and (c) states (if that would not otherwise be apparent) why the exemption applies.

The requested information in questions 1, 2, 5, 6 and 7 is exempt under **Section 21 – Information accessible to applicant by other means**.
