**FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE NO: 01/FOI/25/014353/K**

I write in connection with your request for information dated 05/03/2025, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

*This is an information request relating to vehicles impounded by the force, namely mopeds/scooters and vehicles registered with the motability scheme.*

*Please provide the following information, for the 2019/20, 2020/21, 2021/22, 2022/23, 2023/24 and 2024/25 (to present) financial years:*

- 1. The number of mopeds or scooters impounded in relation to PWITs or drug investigations*

*Please also, for the same financial years, provide the following information:*

- 2. Vehicles (of any kind) impounded for any crime which are registered with the motability scheme. Please provide a breakdown of the types of crime for those impounded*

**Result of Searches**

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by GMP.

However, GMP does not hold the information that you have requested in an easily retrievable format. To provide the data requested in question 1 would involve a manual search of all vehicle seizure records to see what offence the seizure related to.

A search of our seized vehicle records shows that there have been 128,847 vehicles seized. At a very conservative estimate of 5 minutes to locate, retrieve and review each file it would take over 10,000 hours to ascertain the data required.

Therefore, to comply with the whole of your request the process would take over 18 hours' work which exceeds the appropriate limit of £450.00, the amount to which we are legally required to respond.

As per section 12(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, the cost of providing you with the information is therefore above the amount to which we are legally required to respond i.e. the cost of locating and retrieving the information exceeds the 'appropriate level' as stated in the Freedom of Information (Fees and Appropriate Limit) Regulations 2004.

In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000, this letter acts as a Refusal Notice.

GMP is obligated, pursuant to section 16(1) of the Act to provide you with advice and assistance on refining your request to bring compliance within the fees limit. In order for the force to keep this within the fees limit, the information that you are requesting will need to be reduced to a greatly reduced time period. The resulting response cannot be guaranteed at this point as it will be dependent upon the number of records that fall within the scope of any new request, as they would still have to be manually assessed.
