I write in connection with your request for information dated 14/03/2025, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

I would like to know what action your police force has made in response to Martin's Law, if any? I have heard about drop kits and I was curious to know more about what exactly they contain, and their intended use and intended users?

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is not held by GMP.

Martyn's law, or The Terrorism (Protection of Premises) Act 2025 received royal ascent on 3rd April 2025. There will now be an implementation period of at least 24 months where the content, including roles and responsibilities will be finalised. This means that the Act has not yet come into force, therefore it cannot be said that policing activity is implemented under this law.
