FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE NO: 01/FOI/25/014464/Q

I write in connection with your request for information dated 24/03/2025, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

1. *A. For each year (2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025 so far), how many Osman/ threat to life notices has the force issued? B. If possible, how many of these were to those who were Chinese/ Hong Kongers?*
2. *A. Does the force have a means by which it records incidents/reports of transnational repression in your case log? B. If so, for each year (2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025 so far) how many incidents/ reports were logged and C. In each year how many involved a victim who was Chinese/Hong Konger?*
3. *For each year (2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025 so far), how many incidents were recorded of A. harassment, B. stalking, C. online abuse D. Threat, E. Assault, F. foreign interference, where the victim was Chinese or Hong Konger?*
4. *How many officers in the force are fluent Cantonese/ Mandarin speakers?*
5. *Please provide copies of any internal policies of guidance you have on transnational repression.*

Result of Searches

Greater Manchester Police (GMP) does not hold the information that you have requested in an easily retrievable format. To provide the data requested in question 1 would involve a manual search of all Threat to Life Warnings issued in your requested years to establish if the recipient was from China or Hong Kong.

A search of our records show that there are 1,736 records that would have to be manually reviewed. At a very conservative estimate of 5 minutes to locate, retrieve and review each file it would take approximately 145 hours to ascertain the data required.

Therefore, to comply with the whole of your request the process would take over 18 hours' work which exceeds the appropriate limit of £450.00, the amount to which we are legally required to respond.

As per section 12(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, the cost of providing you with the information is therefore above the amount to which we are legally required to respond i.e. the cost of locating and retrieving the information exceeds the 'appropriate level' as stated in the Freedom of Information (Fees and Appropriate Limit) Regulations 2004.

In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000, this letter acts as a Refusal Notice.

GMP is obligated, pursuant to section 16(1) of the Act to provide you with advice and assistance on refining your request to bring compliance within the fees limit. In order for the force to keep this within the fees limit, the information that you are requesting will need to be reduced to a greatly reduced time period. The resulting response cannot be guaranteed at this point as it will be dependent upon the number of records that fall within the scope of any new request, as they would still have to be manually assessed.
