I write in connection with your request for information dated 15/07/2025, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

- 1) *When a Notice of Intended Prosecution is issued by Greater Manchester Police, through the Central Ticket Office, what checks are made to ensure the correct vehicle has been identified by the ANPR/Mobile Speeding Unit Camera?*
- 2) *At any point in the process of issuing a NIP, are there any human interventions/checks made to ensure that notices are not issued incorrectly?*

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by GMP.

Every road safety camera offence is examined by a member of Central Ticket Office (CTO) staff and a verification of the vehicle & VRM captured on the image takes place against the Police National Computer.

For officer witnessed offences or third party submitted offences, checks are made by the officer in the case prior to the offences being submitted to the CTO.
