I therefore ask that you:

**** Re-run the search limited to:***

– the Operation / Event file (including the Gold, Silver and Bronze command logs, risk or threat assessments and the operational briefing) covering the proposed Bob Vylan performance at Radar Festival on 5 July 2025; – any written advice or instruction issued by GMP to Trafford Council or Victoria Warehouse between 1 July and 5 July 2025 concerning that event.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate the requested information and I can confirm the information requested is held by GMP. However, I am not obliged to provide the information requested as exemption applies.
