I write in connection with your request for information dated 25/02/2025, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

Please could you supply the following statistics for the months of October 2024, November 2024, December 2024 and January 2025.

Total recorded crime for each policing division within GMP together with the detection rates for each division.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate the requested information and I can confirm the information requested is held by GMP.

Caveats:

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.

- This data contains crimes with a created date between 01/10/2024 and 31/01/2025, excluding cancelled crimes. Further information about cancelled crimes can be obtained from the Home Office Counting Rules.
- We are aware of various system issues affecting committed at locations for new and migrated crimes (see below for details). These issues mean that data for a specific location may include crimes that did not happen in that location and/or exclude crimes that did.
 - Some crimes do not have a beat code, which means that they cannot be mapped to other geographies e.g. districts.

- Some crimes have an incorrect beat code, which means that they are mapped to the wrong geographies.
- A crime outcome of 'Missing Value' means that the investigation is ongoing and an outcome has not yet been applied.
