Can you please provide me with crime statistics by nationality please between December 2023 and December 2024.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by Greater Manchester Police.

The information listed below has been exempted from disclosure under **Section 40(2) Personal Information** – this information constitutes personal data of an identifiable living individual, and to disclose this information would breach the principles of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018. Personal data is defined by Section 1 of the Data Protection Act 1998 and means data that relates to an individual who can be identified directly or indirectly from that data.

- Combined crime classification and nationalities
- Any count value less than 5

Caveats

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.

- This data contains crimes with a created date between 01/12/2023 and 30/11/2024, excluding cancelled crimes. Further information about cancelled crimes can be obtained from the Home Office Counting Rules.
- There may be more than one suspect attached to a crime. For this reason, the number of total suspects is not the same as the total of crime classification.
- Suspects may be attached to more than one crime during this time period.
- Suspects have been included even if no action has been taken against them e.g. eliminated, insufficient evidence, wanted.
- We are aware of a system issue that allows more than one victim to be attached to a crime, which is incorrect as stated in the Home Office Counting Rules.
