I write in connection with your request for information dated 07/12/2024, I note you seek access to the following information:

How many crimes have been reported on Phoebe Street in the last two years. What were the crimes - have they been solved and people charged?

Has any crimes not had a response or finished with closed investigation without action?

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by Greater Manchester Police.

Caveats

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.

- This data contains crimes with 'Phoebe Street' within the location street field, with a created date between 1st of January 2022 and 31st December 2023, excluding cancelled crimes. Further information about cancelled crimes can be obtained from the Home Office Counting Rules.
- HO Outcome Codes and HO Outcome Descriptions have been included in the data. A crime outcome of 'Missing Value' means that the investigation is ongoing and an outcome has not yet been applied.

Data

The numbers marked 'X' are the ones value less than 5 and have been exempted from disclosure under **Section 40(2) Personal Information** – this information constitutes personal data of an identifiable living individual, and to disclose this information would breach the principles of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018. Personal data is defined by Section 1 of the Data Protection Act 1998 and means data that relates to an individual who can be identified directly or indirectly from that data.

14	Evidential Difficulties Victim Based – Named suspect not identified: The crime is confirmed but the victim either declines/ or is unable to support further police investigation to identify the offender.

15	Named Suspect identified: victim supports police action but evidential difficulties prevent further action.
16	Named Suspect identified: evidential difficulties prevent further action; victim does not support (or has withdrawn support from) police action.
17	Prosecution time limit expired: Suspect identified but prosecution time limit has expired.
18	Investigation Complete: No suspect identified. Crime investigated as far as reasonably possible –Case closed pending further investigative opportunities becoming available
