- 3. How many disclosures made by the force between 1 January 2023 and 1 January 2024 took between 29 days and 50 days?*
- 4. How many disclosures made by the force between 1 January 2023 and 1 January 2024 took between 51 and 100 days?*
- 5. How many disclosures made by the force between 1 January 2023 and 1 January 2024 took more than 100 days?*
- 6. How many people applied to the force for the Domestic Violence Disclosure Scheme (Clare's Law) between 1 January 2024 and 1 July 2025?*
- 7. How many disclosures made by the force between 1 January 2024 and 1 July 2025 were completed within the 28-day time frame.*
- 8. How many disclosures made by the force between 1 January 2024 and 1 July 2025 took between 29 days and 50 days?*

9. How many disclosures made by the force between 1 January 2024 and 1 July 2025 took between 51 and 100 days?

10. How many disclosures made by the force between 1 January 2024 and 1 July 2025 took more than 100 days?

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by GMP.

CAVEATS

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing – the systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold. Any data provided for this request is subject to change as crimes are progressed and/or updated.

The Right to Ask (RTA) and Right to Know (RTK) figures are taken from each Districts Vulnerability Tracker for the period 01/01/2023-31/12/2023 and 01/01/2024-31/12/2024

RTA's are those requested by members of the public. RTK are those requested by GMP.

The data was then filtered for how many of those were disclosed and how long disclosures took

“Unknown” are those with no disclosure date inputted

Where possible duplicates have been removed.

For questions six onwards, July 2025 is in the future, so no information is held for disclosures made in the future.
