FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE NO: 01/FOI/25/014978/L

I write in connection with your request for information dated 23/06/2025, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

On 28/2/2025 [REDACTED] of the Metropolitan Police were found to committed misconduct for breaching professional standards on duties and responsibilities, additionally [REDACTED] for breaching standards on honesty and integrity.

The 2 police officers had attend a domestic incident in East London at 05.04 on 18/2/2023. Due to miscommunication neither police officer completed a DASH (Domestic Abuse, Stalking and Harassment) risk assessment. [REDACTED] completed the DASH on the force computer system without having asked the victim the questions on the DASH. The outcome of the disciplinary hearing was [REDACTED] was given a final written warning and [REDACTED] a written warning.

Q1. Have any police officer in you force been disciplined since 1/1/2013 for either failing to complete a DASH and/or falsifying a DASH.

Q2. If your answer is Yes to question 1 what was the outcome of the disciplinary action?

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by GMP.

CAVEATS

We have taken disciplined/disciplinary action to mean receiving a sanction at misconduct proceedings. As there is no specific way of logging this type of allegation, we have conducted a key word search (DASH) on the cases that have gone to Misconduct Proceedings. Any other method would take well over 18 hours for the time period specified. They may have attended Misconduct proceedings for other matters alongside the DASH allegations.
