I write in connection with your request for information dated 22/04/2025, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

I am current conducting Security Risk Assessment for the Automobile Association. An element of the assessment is to understand the crime within the local area which could impact on the building which the business is located.

As the data is not currently available on the Police.uk website, could your office kindly provide 12 months (Feb 2024 - Feb 2025 or Mar 2024 - Mar 2025) crime stats for each of the following area:

Cheadle Hulme - SK3 0XN

For Feb or March 2025 can you kindly list each crime, its amount and % against the monthly total which is normally shown on the Police.uk website.

Also for the 12 month previous, just the monthly individual crimes total per month would be fine i.e.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that some of the information you have requested is held by GMP.

CAVEATS

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.

This data contains crimes with a community name 'Cheadle Hulme', with a created date between '01/03/2024' and '31/03/2025' excluding cancelled crimes and crimes classified as fraud. Further information about cancelled crimes can be obtained from the Home Office Counting Rules. Details regarding fraud crime can be obtained by contacting the NFIB.

We are aware of various issues affecting committed at locations for some crimes (see below for details). These issues mean that data for a specific location may include crimes that did not happen in that location and/or exclude crimes that did.

- Some crimes do not have a beat code, which means that they cannot be mapped to other geographies e.g. districts.
- Some crimes have an incorrect beat code, which means that they are mapped to the wrong geographies.
- Some crimes do not have an address because e.g. the address has been recorded in a non-standard format or as map coordinates.

Due to low numbers being returned for some crimes, some of the totals have been replaced with X, as by providing exact figures as you have requested would significantly increase the likelihood of identifying the individual(s) concerned, and as such the exemption under S40(2) – Personal Information, would be engaged and result in information being refused. By replacing this data in this way, it can be provided in its entirety.
