I write in connection with your request for information dated 22/09/2025, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

- 1. Please could you state the number of residential burglaries that you have recorded as having taken place on 25.12.24?***
- 2. In relation to all of those offences recorded by you in Q.1 could you provide me with a table showing the Home Office prescribed Outcomes for all of those offences? Eg. Charged, Cautioned, Ongoing, Transferred to Other Force, Evidential Problems etc.***

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate the requested information and I can confirm the information requested is held by GMP.

Caveats:

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.

This data contains residential burglary crimes with a reported date of '25/12/2024', excluding cancelled crimes and crimes classified as fraud. Further information about cancelled crimes can be obtained from the Home Office Counting Rules. Details regarding fraud crime can be obtained by contacting the NFIB.

Due to some low results, and the data being across a specific date period, we have provided the list of applicable outcomes only and not how many for each as by providing all this information as you have requested would significantly increase the likelihood of identifying the individual(s) concerned, and as

such the exemption under S40(2) – Personal Information, would be engaged and result in information being refused. By replacing the data this way, it can be provided in its entirety.

Charged/Summoned
Charged/Summoned Alternative Offence
Evidential Difficulties Victim Based – Named suspect not identified: The crime is confirmed but the victim either declines/ or is unable to support further police investigation to identify the offender.
Investigation Complete: No suspect identified. Crime investigated as far as reasonably possible –Case closed pending further investigative opportunities becoming available
Named Suspect identified: victim supports police action but evidential difficulties prevent further action.
Missing Value – Case/s ongoing.
