I write in connection with your request for information dated 14/08/2025, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

Please can I resubmit my request but deleting any references to asylum status?

How many community resolution orders have been issued for each of the last three years?

Please can a breakdown of the offences committed be given? If going into detail is too time-consuming for an FOI request then please use categories. I.e, indecent exposure could become sexual offences, or ABH to violent crime.

Does the force hold information of the nationality of people handed community resolution orders? If so please provide a nationality breakdown for each year including the offence/offence category for each nationality.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by GMP.

CAVEATS

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.

This data contains crimes with a created date between 01 Jan 2022 and 31 Dec 2024 where the latest outcome is 8 (community resolution), excluding cancelled crimes and crimes classified as fraud. Further information about cancelled crimes can be obtained from the Home Office Counting Rules. Details regarding fraud crime can be obtained by contacting the NFIB.
