I write in connection with your request for information dated 20/02/2026, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

I am requesting the following information held by your constabulary for the periods:

- **1 January to 31 December 2025**
- **1 January to 28 February 2026**

Please provide a breakdown of the data for each council area or policing district within your constabulary's jurisdiction, where applicable.

For each council area/district, please provide:

1. Motorhome-related road traffic collisions

The total number of recorded road traffic collisions involving motorhomes or motor caravans during each period, along with a breakdown by severity (fatal, serious injury, slight injury). Please also confirm the month in each period that recorded the highest number of motorhome-related collisions.

2. Causes of motorhome collisions

The leading recorded causes or contributory factors for collisions involving motorhomes during each period. Where available, please include causes such as driver error or inattention, speeding, poor weather conditions, vehicle defects or mechanical failure, and driver fatigue. Please also indicate the month in which the leading cause resulted in the highest number of motorhome-related collisions.

3. Seasonal trends

Monthly totals for motorhome-related collisions during each period, to identify any seasonal patterns.

4. Driver age groups

The number of motorhome-related collisions involving drivers in the following age groups during each period:

- Under 25 years old
- 25–64 years old
- 65 years old and over

5. Motorhome-related enforcement

Where vehicle type is recorded, the total number of enforcement actions involving motorhomes during each period, including where applicable:

- Speeding offences
- Vehicle defect or roadworthiness offences
- Weight or loading-related offences
- Insurance-related offences

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate the requested information and I can confirm the information requested is held by GMP.

Caveats.

- Please note, on a collision record, a motorhome would be recorded as 'other' vehicle, the other vehicle type is not a mandatory stats 19 field and it may not get completed, especially when the collision is reported by a member of the public via the online system. The type of 'other' vehicle is free typed into the field, if it's added at all. Therefore the data provided are all results from collision where the vehicle type is 'other' and the other type field has been completed.

Due to some low results, the timeframe has been provided as year only as by providing all this information split by individual month as you have requested would significantly increase the likelihood of identifying the individual(s) concerned, and as such the exemption under S40(2) – Personal Information, would be engaged and result in information being refused. By replacing the data this way, it can be provided in its entirety.

we have recorded these range from 49 and above. Providing all this information split by individual or grouped would significantly increase the likelihood of identifying the individual(s) concerned due to such low numbers recorded, and as such the exemption under S40(2) – Personal Information, would be engaged and result in information being refused.

No information held. GMP do not record offences under classification types for vehicles ie “motorhome”.
