I write in connection with your request for information dated 14/07/2026, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

Can I please ask you to provide the crime types and numbers of recorded crimes between June 1st 2023 and May 31st 2026 for the Broughton neighbourhood policing area? Would it also be possible to break the data down, so each year is shown separately please, i.e. 1/6/23 to 31/5/24, 1/6/24 to 31/5/25, and 1/6/25 to 31/5/26??

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by Greater Manchester Police.

Caveats

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.

This data contains crimes with a created date between 01/06/2023 and 31/05/2026 where the community area is 'Broughton', excluding cancelled crimes and crimes classified as non-counting fraud. Further information about cancelled crimes can be obtained from the Home Office Counting Rules. Details regarding fraud crime can be obtained by contacting the NFIB.

We are aware of various system issues affecting committed at locations for new and migrated crimes (see below for details). These issues mean that data for a specific location may include crimes that did not happen in that location and/or exclude crimes that did.

- Some crimes do not have a beat code, which means that they cannot be mapped to other geographies e.g. districts.

- Some crimes have an incorrect beat code, which means that they are mapped to the wrong geographies.
