5. *Of that number. How many were duty related?*
6. *Of the total number. How many were under investigation. Criminal or Police Conduct*

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is not held by GMP.

When a GMP employee dies in service, the cause of death is not recorded on their record. Therefore, no information is held relating to questions 1, 2 and 3 of your request. I advise you make a request to the HM Coroner's Courts as they may hold some relevant information relating to the occupation of people whose deaths have been recorded as suicides.

GMP's Occupational Health Unit do not keep a record of attempted suicides by officers. Therefore no information is held for questions 4, 5 and 6 of your request.
