I write in connection with your request for information dated 13/01/2026, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

Please can I request the local crime statistics for the area of Rusholme for the month of November 2025 please?

We are a residential children's home regulated by Ofsted and are required to update our Local Risk Assessment monthly to ensure the safety of the children's we care for is kept paramount.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by GMP.

CAVEATS

This data contains crimes within b 'A2D1 Rusholme West, A2D2 Victoria Park, A2D3 Birchfields Park, A2D4 Rusholme, A2D5 Rusholme East' and with a created date between 1st November 2025 and 30th November 2025 excluding cancelled crimes and crimes classified as fraud. Further information about cancelled crimes can be obtained from the Home Office Counting Rules. Details regarding fraud crime can be obtained by contacting the NFIB.

We are aware of various issues affecting **committed at locations for some crimes** (see below for details) These issues mean that data for a specific location may include crimes that did not happen in that location and/or exclude crimes that did.

- Some crimes do not have a beat code, which means that they cannot be mapped to other geographies e.g. districts.

- Some crimes have an incorrect beat code, which means that they are mapped to the wrong geographies.
- Some crimes do not have an address because e.g. the address has been recorded in a non-standard format or as map coordinates.

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.

Due to low numbers being returned for some crimes, some of the totals have been replaced with X, as by providing exact figures as you have requested would significantly increase the likelihood of identifying the individual(s) concerned, and as such the exemption under S40(2) – Personal Information, would be engaged and result in information being refused. By replacing this data in this way, it can be provided in its entirety.
