**FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE NO: 01/FOI/25/016069/R**

I write in connection with your request for information dated 30/12/2025, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

***I would like to know how many times in the past 5 years the police have responded to any incident at or directly outside of Bar Eva, Sackville street, Manchester. Please include all incidences of drunk and disorderly or disturbing the peace.***

***Clarification - I am looking for instances of antisocial behaviour, threats of violence, drunk and disorderly, disorderly conduct, drink spiking, underage drinking or general complaints and disturbances that police have attended to either within or directly outside of entrance/ exit of EVA Bar premises.***

**Result of Searches**

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate the requested information and I can confirm the information requested is held by GMP.

Caveats:

**In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.**

This data contains incidents with a postcode of 'M1 3LZ' or '27 Sackville' somewhere within the location fields, with a created date between 01/01/2021 and 31/12/2025 where the incident type is one of 'C01', 'C04', 'C06', 'C11', 'C20', 'C21', 'D08', 'D13', 'D50', 'D80', 'D90', 'D92', 'G06', 'G07', 'G16', 'G23', 'C50', 'C51', 'C52', 'C53', 'C54', 'C56', 'C57', 'C58', 'C59', 'G50', 'G82', 'L15', 'L16', 'L17', 'L28', 'L29', 'L35', excluding incidents with a closing code of L10 Duplicate, L19 Error or L22 Test or training.

We are aware of a system issue affecting **locations for incidents** (see below for details). These issues mean that data for a specific location may include incidents that did not happen in that location and/or exclude incidents that did.

- Some incidents do not have an address because e.g. the address has been recorded in a non-standard format or as map coordinates.

There can be more than one closing code attached to an incident For this reason, the total number incidents may not be the same as the actual number of incidents.
