I write in connection with your request for information dated 16/07/2026, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

I am the deputy manager working across a couple homes within the business and the purpose of this request is to support the completion of a local area risk assessment for a children's residential home. The information will be used to help assess risks within the local community and ensure appropriate safeguarding measures are in place to promote the safety and wellbeing of the young people living at the home.

Please could you provide crime statistics for the local area of Swinton Manchester both north and south districts and I would also need a separate one for Crumpsall also. I would need these covering the 12-month period up to the beginning of July (i.e. from 1 July of the previous year to 30 June of the current year).

If possible, I would like the data to include:

The total number of recorded crimes.

A breakdown by offence category (for example: violence against the person, burglary, vehicle crime, criminal damage, public order, anti-social behaviour, drugs, robbery, theft, shoplifting, sexual offences, and fraud where applicable).

A monthly breakdown of offences.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate the requested information. I can confirm the information requested is held by GMP.

Caveats:

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.

This data contains crimes with a created date between 01/07/2025 and 30/06/2026 where the community area is 'Swinton North', 'Swinton South', 'Lower Crumpsall' or 'Higher Crumpsall', excluding cancelled crimes and crimes classified as non-counting fraud. Further information about cancelled crimes can be obtained from the Home Office Counting Rules. Details regarding fraud crime can be obtained by contacting the NFIB.

Due to low numbers returned per month, the monthly totals have been merged together as by providing all this information split by month and beat as you have requested would significantly increase the likelihood of identifying the individual(s) concerned, and as such the exemption under S40(2) – Personal Information, would be engaged and result in information being refused. By merging this data, it can be provided in its entirety.
