I write in connection with your request for information dated 04/06/2026, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

Request 1:

Please provide the total number of police call-outs/attendances recorded by Greater Manchester Police to the following block of flats over the last 12-months:

West View Court, Northenden, M22 4LP

I would also like a breakdown of these call-outs by category or incident type (for example, crime type/incident classification and call grading, as recorded in your systems).

Request 2:

Please provide the total number of police call-outs/attendances recorded by Greater Manchester Police to the following block of flats over the last 12-months:

Bagnall Court, Northenden, M22 4LT

I would also like a breakdown of these call-outs by category or incident type (for example, crime type/incident classification and call grading, as recorded in your systems).

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate the requested information. I can confirm the information requested is held by GMP.

Caveats:

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.

This data contains incidents with a postcode of 'M22 4LP' or 'M22 4LT' somewhere within the location fields, with a created date between 01/06/2025 and 31/05/2026, excluding incidents with a closing code of L10 Duplicate, L19 Error or L22 Test or training.

We have counted incidents as attended where the earliest arrival timestamp field is not blank. Counts and proportions of incidents with no recorded arrival are presented as a data quality measure. The fact that arrival was not recorded does not necessarily mean that an incident was not attended. Equally, it is not possible to assume that all incidents with no recorded arrival were attended.

Request 1 – West View Court

The search conducted returned no incidents in a 'West View Court'.

Request 2 – Bagnall Court

The search conducted returned 64 incidents attributed to 'Bagnall Court' between 01/06/2025 and 31/05/2026. Of these 64 incidents there is officer arrival data for 42 of them.

Due to the low numbers per incident and that the data relates to a specific postcode/location, we have split the incident type from the total as providing all this information together would significantly increase the likelihood of identifying the individual(s) concerned, and as such the exemption under S40(2) – Personal Information, would be engaged and result in information being refused. By splitting this data, it can be provided in its entirety.

These incidents relate to the following 'Latest Incident Type':
