I write in connection with your request for information dated 13/05/2026, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

Iceland Foods Limited [REDACTED] Claim for the Grant of a new tenancy under Section 24 of the Landlord and Tenant Act 1954 (CPR Part 56)
Property: [REDACTED], Rochdale (the 'Property')

We act for [REDACTED], landlord for the above-named Property.

We are aware that there has been a significant amount of anti-social behaviour around the property, and that the police have attended on numerous occasions.

We would like to request any data or records held by GMP/Rochdale police in regards to their attendance at the Property in the past 2 years.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by GMP.

CAVEATS

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.

This data contains incidents with a created date between 01/01/2024 and 31/12/2025, excluding incidents with a closing code of L10 Duplicate, L19 Error or L22 Test or training.

This data contains incidents with a postcode of OL11 1BL somewhere within the location fields, with a created date between 01/01/2024 and 31/12/2025, excluding incidents with a closing code of L10 Duplicate, L19 Error or L22 Test or training.

We have counted incidents as attended where the earliest arrival timestamp field is not blank.

Counts and proportions of incidents with no recorded arrival are presented as a data quality measure. The fact that arrival was not recorded does not necessarily mean that an incident was not attended. Equally, it is not possible to assume that all incidents with no recorded arrival were attended.

Total incidents 01/01/2024 – 31/12/2025 – 70 incidents recorded in total.

2024 – 15 incidents attended.

2025 – 15 incidents attended.
