I write in connection with your request for information dated 01/06/2026, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

*Freedom of Information Request - Bodycam Footage and Incident Report Regarding [REDACTED]

Dear Greater Manchester Police,

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and as a member of the Media acting in the best interest of the public, I am requesting that you please provide all records that discuss or describe:

Officer(s) Involved: [REDACTED] - detective from South Manchester Child Protection Unit and investigating officer; arresting officer(s) - responded to the scene and conducted the arrest at [REDACTED] residence, names N/A.

Suspect: [REDACTED], Greater Manchester.

Suspects date of birth: N/A

Charges: One count of rape of a girl under the age of 13; one count of rape of a girl under 16 on five occasions; three counts of rape of a girl under the age of 16; two counts of sexual assault of a girl under the age of 13 by touching; and three counts of making indecent images of a child.

Date of incident: Initial arrest date N/A; subsequent arrest date N/A; conviction and sentencing reported September 2025.

Time of incident: N/A

Address of the Arrest: Residence in Wythenshawe, Greater Manchester exact address N/A.

REQUESTING: all bodycam footage for this case in video format. I want all bodycam footage from every officer involved. This includes any and all bodycam video connected to the incident - officers talking with victims, taking the suspect into custody, witnesses, bystanders, or anyone else related. In short: every second of bodycam footage tied to this event and not only the arrest itself. I would also like all interview footage involving the suspect, witnesses, or the victim. Lastly, I'm also requesting the incident report of this case.

I confirm that this request for public records is being made for non-commercial purposes and is intended to serve the public interest. As a news agency, AllAboutCrime seeks to inform and educate the public about government accountability and transparency. The requested records will be used to produce educational and journalistic content shared on YouTube, which serve as modern forums for public discourse. While these platforms may be monetized, the primary purpose of this request is to benefit the public by providing access to critical information. I would request a prompt response to this request. If you deny any or all of this request, please cite each specific exemption you feel justifies the refusal to release the information and notify me of the appeal procedures available to me under the law. Thank you for considering my request.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by GMP. However, I am not obliged to supply you with the information as an exemption applies.

Section 17 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 requires Greater Manchester Police, when refusing to provide such information (because this information is exempt) to provide you, the applicant, with a notice which: (a) states that fact, (b) specifies the exemption in question and (c) states (if that would not otherwise be apparent) why the exemption applies. The information you have requested is exempt from disclosure by virtue of the following exemption: **Section 40(2) – Personal Information.**

Section 40(2) represents information that identifies a living individual, to disclose this information would breach the principles of the Data Protection Act 2018. Personal data is defined by Section 1 of the Data Protection Act 2018 and means data that relates to an individual who can be identified directly or indirectly from that data. Section 40 is an absolute exemption and there is no requirement to conduct a public interest test for such data.
