FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE NO: FOI/26/017075/O

I write in connection with your request for information dated 16/06/2026, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

The speed limit on A34 Kingsway in Manchester was changed from 40mph to 30 mph in August 2025. This included the road from Mosley Road to a point 83m north of the Manchester/Stockport border.

The signage has not been in place for most of this year and was introduced recently.

During the week 11th to 15th May 2026, there were many mobile units conducting speeding checks on both the Northbound and Southbound lanes.

Could I please request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 how many motorists were caught speeding by mobile and fixed cameras on both Northbound and Southbound lanes of the A34 (from where the A34 intersects with Mosley Road, to the point 83m north of the Manchester/Stockport border, i.e. the new speed limit designated 30mph) between 11th May to 15th May inclusive.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate the requested information. I can confirm the information requested is not held by GMP.

CTO did not process any offences for the location and time specified. Greater Manchester Police hold no records of any mobile speed enforcement taking place relating to your request.
