FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE NO: 01/FOI/26/016415/K

I write in connection with your request for information dated 17/02/2026, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

I would like to know the number of crashes, incidents of antisocial behaviour and road traffic offences reported on Lane Head Road, in Oldham.

Relating to the number of crashes, please also include the number of injuries reported, the number of times a driver left the scene and the number of times property was damaged (e.g. a garden wall/ house).

Please can I have this data for the calendar years, 2023, 2024, 2025, and what has been of 2026.

If part of the request cannot be completed, please still complete the remainder.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate the requested information and I can confirm the information requested is held by GMP.

Caveats:

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.

- This data contains anti-social behaviour incidents with a created date between 01 Jan 2023 and 16 Feb 2026, where the street name is 'Lane Head Road' and the district is 'Oldham', excluding incidents with a closing code of L10 Duplicate, L19 Error or L22 Test or training.

- We are aware of system issues affecting locations for incidents (see below for details). These issues mean that data for a specific location may include incidents that did not happen in that location and/or exclude incidents that did.
 - Some incidents do not have an address because e.g. the address has been recorded in a non-standard format or as map coordinates.

Due to some low yearly results, the total number of Anti-Social offences reported have been merged together as by providing all this information split by individual year as you have requested would significantly increase the likelihood of identifying the individual(s) concerned, and as such the exemption under S40(2) – Personal Information, would be engaged and result in information being refused. By replacing the data this way, it can be provided in its entirety.

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Response (Anti-Social)

- **From 2023 – 2026(to date) there have been 7 reports of Anti-Social behaviour.**

Response (Crashes)

- During the time period requested, there has been 1 collision recorded on Lane Head Road, Oldham. There were no reported injuries and the collision is not marked as 'driver left the scene'.
- GMP do not record in damage is caused to property.
