I write in connection with your request for information dated 02/02/2026, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

I am writing to request information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Please provide data relating to offences on roads in England for the most recent three calendar years available.

Specifically, I request:

- 1. A breakdown of roads or local authority areas ranked by the total number of reported hit-and-run incidents per calendar year (2023, 2024, 2025). Please break this down by severity - fatal, serious injury, slight injury, damage-only.*
- 2. How many of these hit and runs did the offenders go unpunished - ie, they evaded capture. Please provide specific details for this - date and time of accident, who was knocked down etc...*
- 3. Could you please also provide data for how many deaths have been recorded per year (2023, 2024, 2025) on each road where more than one fatal collision took place. If possible please note how many people died as a result of each collision, and how many children died*
- 4. Where possible could you confirm what kind of vehicle was driven - and what brand and make of car if known*
- 5. Could you also confirm how many accidents took place on the roads involving police cars.*

6. *Please break this down by - No. of claims, Damages Paid, Police Force Legal Costs paid, Claimant legal costs paid, Total paid*

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate information relevant to your request. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by GMP.

CAVEATS

The figures provided relate to collisions where the field 'Hit and Run' has been completed with 'Yes'. These collisions involve any kind of vehicle involved in a collision with another vehicle or a cyclist or pedestrian and one of the involved parties does not stop to provide details at the scene.

Please consider that the collision recording system will not allow us to query the types of vehicles based on the 'offending' driver. The information provided in response to question 4 lists all vehicles involved, whether they were the driver that left the scene or not.

For question 5, "Police Involved" is when the police vehicle hasn't been crashed but a crash has occurred near the police. I.e: Car stops to allow a police vehicle to pass on blue lights and another member of the public crashes into the car that stops.)

For question 6, the data is only recorded by financial years. The number of claims will not directly correlate with numbers provided for question 5.

3. No road recorded more than one death.
