I write in connection with your request for information dated 21/04/2026, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

Please provide me with the following information:

- 1. For each of the last three financial years (2023/24) (2024/25) and (2025/26) please state the number of female arrests for the offence of being “drunk and disorderly” (Section 91 Criminal Justice Act 1967), broken down by:***
- 2. Of these arrests, please provide a breakdown by age group (i) under 30 and (ii) 30 and over***
- 3. If held, please provide the number of these arrests that resulted in (i) charge/summons, or (ii) and out-of-court disposal (including community resolution)***
- 4. For each of the last three financial years (2023/24) (2024/25) and (2025/26) please state the number of female arrests for public order offences, including offences under Sections 4, 4A and 5 of the Public Order Act 1986, broken down by those aged (i) under 30 and (ii) aged 30 or over.***

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate the requested information and I can confirm the information requested is held by GMP.

Caveats

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing – the systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold. Any data provided for this request is subject to change as crimes are progressed and/or updated.

Management of Police Information regulations state that non-essential records should be removed from police systems six financial years after the year in which they were originally

created. This means that data that is more than six financial years old may be incomplete and should not be compared to more recent data.

- Data provided from 01/04/2023- 31/12/2025 using the CJS Code CJ67002 (*Section 91 Criminal Justice Act 1967*).
- Data is recorded from Jan – Dec and so 2023 – 2024 – 2025 full years have been provided.
- CJSSS Code – PU86149, PU86150, PU86004 and PU86116
