FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE NO: 01/FOI/26/016693/E

I write in connection with your request for information dated 10/04/2026, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

I've been instructed to produce a Crime Impact Statement as part of a planning application for a proposed residential development on land at City Road, Worsley, Greater Manchester, and I believe the site lies within the Astley Mosley Common neighbourhood policing area.

Can I please ask you to provide the crime types and numbers of recorded crimes between February 1st 2023 and 1st February 2026 for the Astley Mosley Common neighbourhood policing area? Would it also be possible to break the data down, so each year is shown separately please?

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate the requested information and I can confirm the information requested is held by GMP.

Caveats:

In July 2019, GMP implemented one of the largest IT infrastructure changes in UK policing. The systems are in continual development and the data provided for this request is what the systems currently hold.

- This data contains crimes which occurred on the reported beat L2X1 – Astley Moss Common with a created date between 01/02/2023 and 01/02/2026, excluding cancelled crimes. Further information about cancelled crimes can be obtained from the Home Office Counting Rules.
- We are aware of various system issues affecting committed at locations for new and migrated crimes (see below for details). These issues mean that data for a specific location may include crimes that did not happen in that location and/or exclude crimes that did.

- Some crimes do not have a beat code, which means that they cannot be mapped to other geographies e.g. districts.
- Some crimes have an incorrect beat code, which means that they are mapped to the wrong geographies.
- Some crimes do not have an address because e.g. the address has been recorded in a non-standard format or as map coordinates.
- Please note - only 1 crime was recorded on the 1st Feb 2026 which has been included in the 1st Feb 25 – 31st Jan 26 figure.
- Due to some low results, some data may have been replaced with X, as by providing all this information split by individual offence as you have requested would significantly increase the likelihood of identifying the individual(s) concerned, and as such the exemption under S40(2) – Personal Information, would be engaged and result in information being refused. By replacing the data this way, it can be provided in its entirety.
